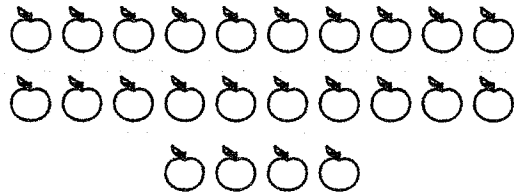

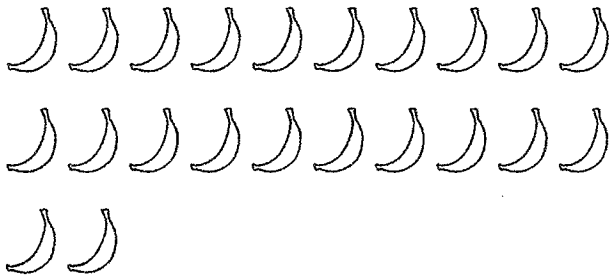

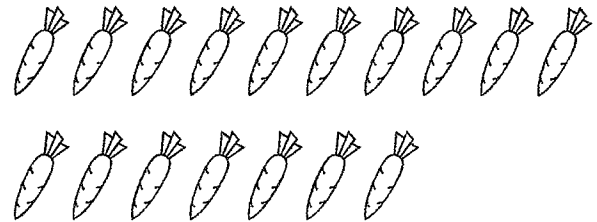
Circle each complete group of ten. Write how many tens, how many ones, and how many in all. For example:



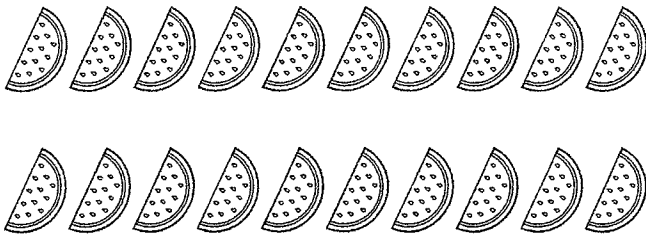
